The Minutes of the Last Annual Meeting

The annual meeting of Midland Lutheran Church was held on February 10, 2019 with Fred Behnken, congregation secretary, presiding. The meeting was called to order at 11:34 with a prayer. There were 21 members attending.

Fred explained the purpose of the meeting was to vote for representatives to council. He described the council as more of a visioning committee, now that we are renting space from the Chinn's, to determine what our mission is for the future and what actions we need to take to achieve that mission.
